Rules and Regulations

**PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED AND MUST BE DONE VIA OUR WEBSITE
PRIOR TO 6 P.M. ON FRIDAY, AUGUST 20.**

Fish any body of water

6:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, August 21

Since the idea behind the event is parent/child interaction, this event is open to ANY and all lakes, rivers and streams you choose to fish. We want children from anywhere to participate and have fun. This event is not about who caught the biggest fish, but getting children more involved with fishing and their parents. With the help of our sponsors we hope to have a little something for every child that registers. Catching a fish is NOT required to receive a door prize.

Register fish by 3:30 p.m. at Lower Rock Lake Park, North end of Rock Lake, Lake Mills, WI.

The registration time of 3:30 p.m. is the same regardless of where you choose to fish.

The registration station will be located at the Lower Rock Lake Park in Lake Mills, WI. Lake Mills is located just off of I-94 between Milwaukee and Madison. The park is located on HWY B on the north end of Rock Lake. If traveling from Milwaukee or Madison, you will take I-94 to the Lake Mills Exit (WI-89). At the top of the off-ramp, you will head south on 89 toward Kwik Trip/McDonalds. At the stop light, take

a right onto Hwy V. At the next stop sign you will take a right on Hwy B. Follow this around the north end of Rock Lake, just past where the water meets the road, take the road to the left which takes you to the park and the boat landing. Once you have launched, you will park across Hwy B from the launch and walk through a tunnel to return to your boat. The registration station will be under the pavilion at this park.

Food, trophies and door prizes after 3:30 when all fish are registered (must be present for door prizes).

Every child receives a door prize just for participating—and three trophies for each age bracket will be handed out for the largest fish in each bracket. An overall largest fish trophy also will be awarded.

A cookout is planned following the trophy presentation. In years past, we have been able to supply both lunch and dinner. Being able to do this is never a promise since this whole event is put on with the help of sponsors and donations can vary from year to year.

Age brackets

3-7 years old | 8-12 years old | 13-17 years old

POINT SYSTEM USED FOR REGISTRATION

Bluegill.....	4 points per inch
Crappie/Perch.....	3 points per inch
Walleye/Smallmouth/Largemouth.....	2 points per inch
Northern Pike/Musky	1.25 points per inch

How does the point system work? First off, the child only needs to register ONE fish*. If he/she has a 10-inch bluegill and a 31-inch northern pike, register the bluegill. The bluegill would equal 40 points (10 inches X 4 points per inch). The northern pike would score 38.75 points (31 inches X 1.25 points per inch). A 32-inch northern would be the same as a 10-inch bluegill. This system seems strange to some, but when the math is done, a trophy=a trophy, regardless of species. This also helps children with no boat to have a chance to place.

****More than one fish can be registered but only one fish will count.***

- Adults are asked to help youth fish, however, ONLY registered youth entrants catches may be registered.
 - Late registration may result in disqualification.
 - In the event of a tie, the earliest fish registered will take the higher placing.
